## 195.1 Apologies and Welcome

There were no members of the public present. There were no members of the press present.

Ms Forster welcomed everyone.

- Declarations of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests, including any dispensations of pecuniary interest None
- 3. The clerk presented a projected income and expenditure statement to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024 and possible budget for 2024-25, with a suggested precept demand of £13,000.
- 4. Discussion took place about the amount of precept to demand from ERYC. It was proposed by Ms Forster and seconded by Mr Wright and agreed unanimously to fund the insurance for Allerthorpe Village Hall for one more year at a projected cost of £1500.
- 5. Mr Sutton also asked the Parish Council if they would consider buying new tables for the Village Hall, to complete its renovation and upgrade. The projected cost of this is £2,500. After some discussion it was proposed by Mr Sutton and seconded by Ms Forster and unanimously agreed to do so mainly out of accumulated funds.
- 6. A final discussion about the precept demand was followed by a proposal of £14,500 made by Mr Wilkinson and seconded by Mr Mace. It was unanimously agreed that this amount would reflect the general increase in wages and prices expected in the next financial year and also enable the Village Hall Management Committee to finally finish an almost completed refurbishment of the Village Hall.
