<u>Parish Council Meeting</u>: The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on 28th Jul and 1st Oct 2014 at 8:00pm.

Members of the Public & Press are welcome at meetings of Allerthorpe Parish Council. Public Participation will commence prior to the start of the full council meeting when members of the public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.

<u>Upkeep of Grass Verges:</u> The Parish Council would like to thank all those residents who maintain the grass verges outside their properties by cutting the grass on a more regular basis that that scheduled by the ERYC. It really helps to give the Village a pristine look and cared for image.

<u>Village Planters:</u> The Village Planters have recently been revitalised with some pansies pending the summer bedding plants going out. We are very grateful to Penny and Margaret for the wonderful job they have done again. We are always on the lookout for suitable plants throughout the year so please let us know if you have any cuttings that you could donate.

<u>Grass Cutting and Road Sweeping:</u> We have been advised that the ERYC has increased the number of times these functions are carried out and we should now see them visiting on a 15 (working) day cycle.

Neighbourhood Plan: We have now reached a stage where the questionnaire to all residents and businesses in the Parish are being finalised and should be distributed in July. This subject was explained in depth to all those who attended the Annual Parish Meeting on 28th May.

<u>High-speed Broadband - Update:</u> The Village is in the identified intervention area for the 'Broadband East Riding' project. This is an ongoing project co-ordinated by the ERYC and part of the Government's national broadband programme. BT is the appointed contractor. Overall, the project will deliver superfast broadband to over 42,000 homes and businesses in the intervention area by December 2015, however, don't get your hopes too high. The aim is only to provide a reliable basic broadband service of at least 2Mbps.

Summer B-B-Q: The Village Hall Committee is arranging a Village BBQ for the 19th July. Please note the date in your diary and further details will be announced nearer the date.
