**Parish Council Meeting**: The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on 20<sup>th</sup> May 2015 at 8:00pm.

Members of the Public & Press are welcome at meetings of Allerthorpe Parish Council. Public Participation will commence prior to the start of the full council meeting when members of the public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.

Annual Village Meeting: The Local Government Act 1972 requires every English Parish to hold a Parish Meeting each year between 1<sup>st</sup> March and 1<sup>st</sup> June and this year's meeting will be held in the Village Hall on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> May at 8:00 pm. An Agenda will be published on the notice board a week prior to the meeting. Please come along, this is an open meeting for you to raise any matters relating to the Parish.

**Broadband East Riding** The project continues to roll out faster broadband to many parts of the East Riding and *superfast broadband* is now available to over 24,000 homes. Allerthorpe is now fibered and you need to contact your ISP to get connected.

<u>Crime Prevention Panel</u> The panel in the Wolds Weighton and Pocklington area has existed since the middle of the 1960s and we are looking for a volunteer to represent the Parish Council. Please make contact if you feel you could support your community in this way.

**Parish Council Elections:** The next Parish Council elections will be held on Thursday 7th May 2015.

All 7 Councillors who serve on Allerthorpe Parish Council are elected into office and the process is overseen by The East Riding Yorkshire Council.

- ➤ The Parish Council is a tier of local government closest to the people.
- ➤ It is a non political institution, which represents the whole of its community.
- ➤ It is sensitive to the views and aspirations of those whom it serves.

<u>Defibrillator:</u> The PC is exploring funding for the supply of a Defibrillator to be mounted on the external wall of the Village Hall and would like to hear from anyone willing to be trained to use the equipment.
