<u>Parish Council Meeting</u>: The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on Monday 23rd May 2016 and Monday the Annual Parish Meeting will be on Wednesday 25th May at 8:00pm in the Village Hall.

Members of the Public & Press are welcome at meetings of Allerthorpe Parish Council. <u>Public Participation will commence prior to the start</u> of the full council meeting when members of the public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.

<u>Wanted - Parish Clerk</u>: The Parish Council would like to hear from any member of the community who would like to take up the post of part-time Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer to the Allerthorpe Parish Council.

Applicants should have basic IT skills, experience in financial accounting and budgeting and the preparation of Agenda for, and the accurate recording of Minutes of meetings. Access to a computer, printer and the internet will be made available. An average 10 hours per week applies to the post. Any additional hours will be paid as overtime at normal rates. Some evening work is involved.

The salary will be within the NALC/SLCC Scale LC1 (SCP 15-27 $\pounds 8.344 - \pounds 11.932$) pro-rata to the number of hours worked and subject to experience and qualifications and is due for review in March 2016.

<u>Village Hall Amenities:</u> We are pleased to announce that, with the aid of a number of funding grants we have been able to upgrade the Village Hall with a complete package of Audio Visual Aids, including a projection screen, and ceiling mounted projector, and are now in the process of completing the project with a microphone, amplifier and speaker system. We have no doubt that this will make the hall much more attractive to potential hirers not only for educational lectures but also for children's parties and other celebrations.

<u>Community Payback:</u> We have once again had the services of the Community Payback team in the Village and they have edged out the footpath from the telephone kiosk all along the South West of Main Street to where it ends at The Old Granary making it again possible to walk the path with a buggy or pushchair.
