<u>Parish Council Meeting</u>: The next meetings of the Parish Council will be on Monday 30th January 2017 and Monday 27th March 2017 at 8:00pm in the Village Hall.

Members of the Public & Press are welcome at meetings of Allerthorpe Parish Council. <u>Public</u> <u>Participation will commence prior to the start of the full council meeting when members of the</u> <u>public can raise questions or make statements to the Parish Council about any issues they may</u> <u>have. Because we are restricted to only 10 minutes, the public are encouraged to use this facility</u> <u>as an opportunity to raise issues rather than to seek resolution and in most cases the council will</u> <u>need to make referrals before being able to provide researched answers.</u>

Vacancy - Parish Clerk: The Parish Council would like to hear from any member of the community who would like to take up the post of part-time Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer to Allerthorpe Parish Council.

Applicants should have basic IT skills, experience in financial accounting and budgeting and the preparation of Agenda for, and the accurate recording of Minutes of meetings. Access to a computer, printer and the internet will be made available. An average 10 hours per week applies to the post. Any additional hours will be paid as overtime at normal rates. Some evening work is involved.

The salary will be within the NALC/SLCC Scale LC1 (SCP 15-27 \pounds 8.717 - \pounds 12.440) pro-rata to the number of hours worked and subject to experience and qualifications and is due for review in March 2018.
